HOME
Take pictures of internal & external home building & contents, save digitally Put copies of insurance info in all vehicles & fire safe box Save digital copies of insurance & id documents "to the cloud" Ensure extra batteries available for flashlights Check surge-protectors are in working condition Ensure portable/back up batteries available for electronic devices Evaluate pet crates/carriers, clean & label Put up-to-date vaccine records & vet contact info with pet crates/carriers Check leashes & collars in good condition, tags up-to-date Check & repair all gutters, downspouts, & drain lines to facilitate drainage Review roof & siding for damage or weak spots
LIVESTOCK
<ul> <li>Check &amp; repair shelter roofing</li> <li>Check fence lines for weak spots</li> <li>Check &amp; repair gate posts &amp; hinges</li> <li>Check gate latches &amp; secure chains or fasteners</li> <li>Evaluate electric fencer, grounding &amp; connections</li> <li>Evaluate feed &amp; bedding storage, maintain 2 week minimum on-site</li> <li>Check water lines, replace as needed</li> </ul>
EQUIPMENT
O Take pictures of internal & external garage and equipment sheds, save digitally O Check and repair equipment shelters O Sharpen chains & blades, ensure extras available O Evaluate & clean generator, locate for immediate use O Change fluids and filters, check brakes, grease as needed O Evaluate & fill fuel cans (gas, diesel, small engine mix)

## Emergency Preparedness on the Homestead 48 Hour Storm-Prep Checklist

Wash & dry laundry Clean (mop & vacuum) floors Wash dishes & run dishwasher Clean indoor pet facilities Charge backup batteries & electronics Locate & label keys for quick access Stage rain gear, boots & gloves for quick access Change flashlight batteries & stage around house
<ul><li>Fill empty freezer space with water bottles</li><li>Empty all food leftovers &amp; clean refrigerator</li></ul>
O Store 5 gallon buckets of water for toilets
O Secure all outdoor furniture and accessories
LIVESTOCK
O Scrub water buckets & troughs, fill
O Move rotational housing to clean ground
<ul><li>Move livestock to storm shelter locations</li><li>Locate &amp; label leads &amp; leashes for quick access</li></ul>
O Fill all feeders, secure loose or empty troughs, feeders & stations O Refresh all bedding
O Stage additional food & bedding near shelters
O Scrub additional buckets/containers, stage for rainwater collection
EQUIPMENT
Fill fuel in all vehicles & equipment
O Fill extra fuel tanks
O Prep chainsaw, pole saw, shovels & tow straps
O Fill and stage generator O Mow & weed eat paths & fence lines
O Move equipment & vehicles to shelter
